Two luxury ships will join as a part of the new Evolution-class with the first being launched in 2022. A new expedition vessel named Silver Origin and accommodating 100 guests will enter service in the Galapagos Islands in March 2020. Two other ships in the Museclass, the Silver Moon and Silver Dawn, will be sailing in a few years and the Silver Spirit recently underwent a major refurbishment and was lengthened by 49 feet.
